PALPA – A BACKGROUND

Pakistan Air Line Pilots' Association (PALPA) is a professional body representing the permanently employed pilots in the National Airline. It was formed in 1954 and is the member of International Federation of Air Line Pilots' Association (IFALPA) and ITF. PALPA is an important member of these world bodies and our pilots have been significant members of these renowned world bodies.

The membership of PALPA consists of 450 members who are in active service of PIA and 400 members who have retired from PIA. The membership is represented by the elected Executive Committee comprising 14 members from the serving pilots and two from the retired pilots.

The governing rules and regulations are stipulated in the PALPA Constitution. The Association is housed at ST-31, BLOCK-5, KEHKASHAN, CLIFTON, KARACHI. The premises are owned by the Association and its entire Management is done by the Executive Committee of PALPA.
