## INFO CREW SLIP AT PESHAWAR.

**Dear Members:** 

January 15, 2010.

The Management has altered the January roster to introduce slip at Peshawar. This hasty move is not understandable as only a couple of weeks back, the entire post Haj Operations was conducted successfully and safely without slipping at Peshawar.

For the said Haj Operation, the Executive Committee had assured, the Management that the flights going in and out of Peshawar will not be hampered even if the crew is not made to slip at Peshawar. The reason for agreeing to this arrangement was simply for the safety and security of the crew as we have already lost a senior colleague in Peshawar PC terror attack.

The Executive Committee is cognizant of the feelings of the membership and the apprehensions crew has against staying/lodging in Peshawar, for the simple reason that the security status in the city of Peshawar is not conducive to crew slipping in that city.

The Executive Committee has decided to take up the matter with the Management and persuade them to conduct operations to Peshawar without planning any slip. This is a matter of serious concern which shall be taken upto the highest level.
