Further to PALPA FLASH dated 25th January 2010 on Crew Layover at Peshawar.

The Executive Committee communicated its concern twice to the Ministry of Defence, Director General CAA-Pak and PIA Management with facts and figures, highlighting the security situation in Peshawar.

The details of the bomb blasts/terrorist attacks and the consequent fatalities and injuries in the major cities of Pakistan have been tabulated in abridged form below for your information.
